Greater Burlington YMCA Waiver and Release Form

I understand that the YMCA of the USA has adapted a program guideline that provides that "starling blocks are placed only in the deep end of the pool in no less than 5 feet of water."

I understand that the YMCA of the USA guideline differs from the rules and regulations of United States Swimming, Inc. (USA Swimming) which allow starling blocks to be used in water less than 5 feet deep.

I understand that the Greater Burlington YMCA board of directors has voted to authorize the use of starting blocks in a manner that conforms to United States Swimming, Inc. rules and regulations.

I understand that the use of a starting block carries a risk of death or serious injury including paralysis that might result in permanent and total disability.

I voluntarily assume all risk of injury or death resulting from the use of starting blocks in a manner that conforms to United States Swimming, Inc. rules and regulations.

I hereby waive all claims and release the Greater Burlington YMCA and its officers, agents, and employees from any liability for injury or death arising from the use of starting blocks in a manner that conforms to United States Swimming, Inc. rules and regulations.

GREATER BURLINGTON YMCA DYNAMO SWIM TEAM
CODE OF CONDUCT

Purpose: The purpose of this code is to promote individual and team responsibility. We want to help swimmers learn to be good citizens and positive role models. The YMCA Core Values of Caring, Honesty, Respect and Responsibility will be promoted at all times.

Note: Coaches will do everything to ensure the safety of the swimmers at all times during practice time. In the event that a swimmer violates the code of conduct and or Dynamo rules, parents will be called/emailed and made known of the violation and consequence following practice.

Part I Expected Behavior

Expected Behavior at all Dynamo Activities

1. Act and conduct myself with dignity and respect for others and property of others.
2. Always practice and teach good sportsmanship.
3. Promote positive high team spirit and morale.
4. Offer congratulations to my opponents, win or lose, and to cheer on my teammates.
5. Be a responsible goodwill ambassador between the sport of swimming and the public.

Prohibited Behavior

1. Bullying
2. Belligerent, aggressive, or disrespectful behavior towards swimmers or Coaches.
3. Destructive behavior toward oneself, others or property of the YMCA.
4. Inappropriate or unruly behavior, including failure to adhere to team standards and YMCA Core Values.
5. Use of alcoholic beverages, tobacco products and illegal drugs.

At Travel Meets

1. Swimmers must attend all team meetings and report on deck at assigned time.
2. Swimmers must wear designated team apparel such as caps and t-shirts with Dynamo emblem.
3. At all times, swimmers must show respect towards team chaperones and fellow swimmers, especially in matters of safety and discipline.
4. Swimmers and parents acknowledge that coaches and chaperones are in charge of policies and procedures at Travel Meets. Parents who attend are merely spectators and do not function in a supervisory role unless a coach expressly asks a spectator parent to do so.
5. Swimmers must obey the established nightly curfew.

Part II Violation of the Code of Conduct

Consequences for Violation of the Code of Conduct:

1. Swimmers will sit out of practice ON DECK for a said amount of time determined by the coach. Parent/guardian's will be notified of inappropriate behavior and the consequence after practice.
2. Swimmer may not be permitted to attend practice.
3. Eliminating all non-swimming privileges such as games, parties and outings.
4. Suspension from swim meet(s).
5. Temporary or permanent dismissal from the team without a refund.

If inappropriate behavior occurs during Travel Meet:

6. Sending the swimmer home at additional expense, to be borne by the swimmer and his/her parents.
7. Scratching the athlete from subsequent events.
8. The swimmer may not be invited to attend future Travel Meets.

Part III Pick Up and Drop Off

Pick up and Drop Off Policy:

1. During, and only during practice times are swimmers under the coach's supervision. It is imperative that parents drop off and pick up swimmers at the appropriate practice times.
2. The coaches and the YMCA staff cannot hold anyone against their will. Coaches and YMCA staff will do everything within their legal power to prevent swimmers from leaving the pool deck and/or building during practice times. In the event that a swimmer leaves the pool deck and/or building without permission by the coach, parents will be notified immediately.
